

**Mark A. Moore** (PhD, Columbia University, Economics) is a Senior Lecturer for Simon Fraser University's Beedie School of Business. He has taught economics at Columbia University, Colgate University and the University of British Columbia. Mark has prepared research reports for the Frontier Centre for Public Policy and the Inter-American Development Bank, and has consulted for the Qikiqtani Inuit Association. His current research is on policy options for governments and Indigenous groups attempting to share in the profits of non-renewable resource firms.
