

Aidan Vining is the emeritus CNABS Professor of Business and Government Relations, Simon Fraser University in Vancouver, Canada. He holds a Ph.D. from the Goldman School of Public Policy at the University of California, Berkeley. Aidan has authored over a hundred articles in peer-reviewed journals including the Journal of Public Administration Research and Theory (JPART), the Journal of Policy Analysis and Management (JPAM), and the Annals of Public and Co-operative Economics.
