Lawrence Schembri is a senior fellow and Peter M. Brown Chair in Canadian Competitiveness at the Fraser Institute. Mr. Schembri joined the Bank of Canada in 1997 as a senior research director, and over time was promoted to more senior positions, eventually serving as a deputy governor in the Bank's Governing Council from 2013 until his retirement in June 2022. In this role, he initially oversaw the Bank's analysis and activities to promote a stable and efficient financial system, and subsequently, he oversaw the Bank's analysis and projection of the Canadian economy. He also served as the Bank's executive sponsor for

its Indigenous outreach program and helped establish the Central Bank Network for Indigenous Inclusion. He currently serves on the board of three Indigenous non-profit organizations that focus on economic development, education and housing and as a consultant for the IMF and World Bank. His research interests include central banking, macroeconomic policy, the Indigenous economy and economic literacy. Mr. Schembri received a BCom from the University of Toronto, an MSc in economics from the London School of Economics, and a PhD in economics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Prior to joining the Bank of Canada, he was an associate professor of economics at Carleton University.
